Regular Scheduled Meeting
April 24, 2017

Mayor Doug Burgess called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. The Town Clerk called the roll with the following present: Commissioner Efir, Commissioner Broadway, Mayor Burgess and Commissioner Harvey. Commissioner Huneycutt was not in attendance.
