Ms. Latoya Jackson was sworn in as Commissioner with the Town Board of Oakboro by Notary, Jim Cameron prior to meeting on April 1, 2019.

Mayor Little welcomed everyone and had Town Clerk call roll. Those present: Commissioner Efird, Commissioner Huneycutt, Commissioner Smith, Mayor Little, Commissioner Watkins, Commissioner Jackson and Town Administrator, Doug Burgess.

The Board discussed different properties in the town that needed cleaning up. Chief Smith is to get a list of the properties that need the most work.

Commissioner Watkins made a motion to use AD Construction to upgrade the newly purchased building on 3rd street to house Police Department and is allowed to spend up to \$33,000.00. Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.




