

# **Town Of Oakboro**

**Board of Commissioners**

**Followed by Continued Meeting**

**Mayor Little opened the Public Hearing to hear comments, for or against, a request from Kenneth Smith to have property on corner of Alonzo and Dorsett streets rezoned from R-15 to R-9M (multi-family). With no one signing up to speak, Mayor Little declared the Public Hearing Closed.**

**Mayor Little opened the continued meeting with prayer and had the Town Clerk call the roll with the following present: Commissioner Efird, Commissioner Huneycutt, Commissioner Smith, Mayor Little, Commissioner Watkins, Commissioner Jackson and Doug Burgess.**

**Commissioner Huneycutt made a motion to change the zoning at the corner of Alonzo and Dorsett streets changed from R-15 to R-9M. Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**

**Commissioner Efird made a motion to call a Public Hearing for November 18, 2019. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to consider comments concerning a request from Joseph Burleson to have zoning on a parcel of land (18 (+/-) acre tract of land on Hatley Burris Rd. Deed Book 1634/page 459) changed from R-15 to R-9. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**

**Chief Smith reported that his department would be participating in "No Shave November". All monies received will benefit Western Stanly Shop with a Cop.**

**The Chief also reported that Vocational Rehabilitation Services of NC has offered to provide an intern for the Oakboro Police Department for up to 28 hours/week for a period of 4 months with no cost for the Town of Oakboro.**

**Commissioner Huneycutt made a motion to hire an intern from Vocational Rehabilitation Services of NC to work in the Oakboro Police Department at \$13.00/hour paid for by Vocational Rehabilitation Services of NC. Commissioner Watkins seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**

**Town Administrator, Doug Burgess, reported that the bid for the town's property at the corner of 1<sup>st</sup> and Alonzo St., was increased from \$18,000. to \$19,050.**

**Commissioner Watkins made a motion to re-advertise the sale of the Town's property in the Stanly News and Press for further bidding. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**

**Chief Smith reported that the Stanly County Board of Education has funding from a grant to pay for a school resource office at Oakboro Choice Stem School. Oakboro has to provide car, uniform, gun, computer etc. Smith offered that Sgt. Bryce Kaus would be perfect for this position.**

**Commissioner Huneycutt made a motion to allow Sgt. Kaus to be the Student Resource Officer at Oakboro Choice Stem School funded by the Stanly County Board of Education. Commissioner Efird seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**

**Commissioner Efird made a motion to adjourn meeting. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.**
