



A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO CONSIDER AN AMENDMENT TO THE TOWN CHARTER TO INCREASE THE LENGTH OF THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, The N.C. General Assembly created the Town of Oakboro by “An Act to Incorporate the Town of Oakboro in Stanly County” on February 15, 1915. The 1915 Act is sometimes referred to as the Town Charter or Charter; and

WHEREAS, The Charter has subsequently been amended by ordinance as provided by the authority found in the N.C. General Statutes at sections 160A-101 and 160A-102; and


WHEREAS, The Charter was amended adopted on June 16, 2009 to increase the length of the terms of the Commissioners from two to four years. The term of the mayor is two years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wish to consider an ordinance to increase the term of the mayor from two to four years as provided by N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 160A-101 and 160A-102.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1) The Board of Commissioners intent to consider an amendment to the Town Charter Section 15, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §160A-101 (4), to add the following sentence: The term of office of the mayor shall be four years and until a successor is elected and qualified.
- 2) The Clerk is directed to advertise a Public Hearing on the proposed ordinance to be held at the regularly scheduled Board of Commissioners meeting on February 19, 2024.

THIS RESOLUTION was approved on January 27, 2024 by the Board of Commissioners by a vote of five for and zero against.
