


**ORDER CLOSING AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF A STREET
IN THE TOWN OF OAKBORO, N.C.**

Whereas, The Board of Commissioners as authorized by North Carolina General Statute §160A-299, declares its intent to close and abandon a portion of a street (lane or alleyway) lying within the boundary of N.C. Property Identification Numbers 559302656809, containing 309.55 ac. more or less. The purpose of this is abandonment of the 295.6-foot portion of street shown on Map Book 1725 Page 473(10) of the Stanly County Registry.


Now, Therefore, be it **Resolved** that the Board of Commissioners intends to close and abandon that portion of the street as drawn on the attached plat, pursuant to the provisions of North Carolina General Statute §160A-299, and that a public hearing to consider the question of closing and abandoning such portion of the said street be set for March 18, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. at the regular meeting of the Commissioners. It is directed that the Resolution of Intent to Close and Abandon be published once a week for four (4) successive weeks prior to the hearing; that a copy of the Resolution be sent by certified or registered mail to the owners of the properties adjacent to the portion of the street to be closed, as shown on the County tax records; that a notice of the closing be prominently posted in at least two (2) places along the portions of the street to be closed and a copy of the Resolution be mailed to the North Carolina Department of Transportation.
